Membership of the Club is open to anyone with a genuine interest in natural history, local history and archaeology, particularly of the Whitby area. There are three categories of membership: Ordinary Members, Junior Members, and Honorary Members (by election only). Junior Members shall be over 8 and under 16 on 1st January of the current year. They will be accompanied by an adult Member who will accept responsibility for them. They shall not be eligible to serve on any Committee nor vote at General Meetings.

Benefits of membership. All Members receive the Club's Annual Report, and information about Club events. They may also access the Club website's forum. A donation is requested from people attending each Club lecture. The suggested amount is £1 for Members and £2 for visitors.

To join, please complete this Membership Application Form and send it together with a cheque (payable to the Whitby Naturalists' Club) for the current year's subscription to the Club's Membership Secretary. Membership is free for Honorary Members and Junior Members. The annual subscription for Ordinary Members is currently £10 (or £5 for those under 21 years old on 1st January AND in full-time education). Please note that, for Ordinary Members, membership is not valid until the annual subscription has been received by the Treasurer.
